



Wasauksing Marina Campground

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Use of the campground is at your own risk and management assumes no responsibility for conduct leading to an accident, injury, or property damage.

- You are authorized to utilize the site for your enjoyment and for the duration of your rental agreement, under any circumstance you are not allowed to build permanent structures.
- If you are going to utilize a boat for the summer, you are instructed to rent a slip at the Marina.
- Firearms are strictly prohibited.
- Use of fireworks with permission of Marina Management.
- Cutting trees and shrubs and plant removal strictly prohibited.
- Management reserves the right to refuse any camper due to appearance and/or condition.
- All campers must check in at the office before setting up.
- Please drive slowly (5 km per Hour) and watch for children.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted outside of any camper.
- Pets must be on a leash and all owners must pick up after their pets. We require all animals to have rabies vaccination tags on its collar. Pet owners are responsible for their dog's behavior. We do not allow Rottweiler's or Pit bulls.
- Quiet time begins at 10:00 PM through to 8 AM. Any excessive noise is prohibited at all times. Failure to abide by this rule will result in your camping privileges being revoked.
- All children under the age of 12 must be in their campsites by 9 PM unless accompanied by an adult. No children or dependent under the age of 19 is permitted to occupy the campsite unless accompanied by an adult.
- For your safety, we recommend that all children wear water safety gear while in the water. Adults are responsible for watching their children at all times while staying at Wasauksing Campground.
- Snakes like to lay on, around and underneath rocks so be extremely careful. Snakes are protected by "Species at Risk".
- If you require firewood for your campsite please contact the Marina Manager.
- Campfires must be in campfires ring and all campers must have a fire extinguisher. All fires must be put out before going to bed or leaving the campsite. Absolutely no campfires during windy or dry conditions. Please adhere to all fire rating warnings

posted at the Marina. Failure to adhere to posted fire ratings could result in a fine or prosecution.

- 1 car per campsite - Only valid drivers permitted to operate vehicles. No blocking entrances to other campsites. Additional parking is available.
 - Please respect other campers as well as their property. (Please address complaints to Marina Manager)
 - Do not walk or drive across other campsites.
 - Pick up trash at all times. We do not recommend leaving food or trash outside due to Bears. Garbage to be placed in designated containers and location.
 - Renters are responsible for keeping campsites clean. Please help keep the Wasauksing campgrounds clean.
 - Feeding of wildlife is prohibited.
 - Discharge of sewage or gray water into or on land is prohibited.
 - Valid permits/licenses required for fishing.
 - All RV must be maintained in a fully mobile condition with a current RVIA certification.
 - Any violations of these rules can cause eviction without notice or refund.
